Troops & Teams could set up a model campsite as a campsite safety quiz, do 1st aid relays, erect pioneering gadgets, or select any merit badge topic. Crews can exhibit any high adventure-related items and equipment. The district is recruiting a number of outside groups with Scouting-related products or services to help you develop your program resource list.
