

New Scout Paperwork

All new Scouts must fill out an application form – no exceptions.

Scouts who registered last year do not have to fill out an application this year.

New Adult Leaders must fill out an Adult application form.

All Adult Leaders (including Committee Members) who have filled out an application a previous year do not have to fill out an application – unless -

Leaders and Committee Members changing positions for this Scout year **MUST** fill out a new application and write “CHANGE OF POSITION” at the top. No fee will be assessed the Pack for a change of position. Here are examples of changes in position:

Leadership to Committee
Committee to Leadership
Tiger Leader to Wolf/Bear
Tiger Leader to Webelos
Wolf/Bear to Tiger
Wolf/Bear to Webelos
Webelos to Tiger
Webelos to Wolf/Bear

A change in the position within a Committee is **NOT** considered a change in position. For example, a change from Secretary to Treasurer is not considered a change in position.

In the event that a boy is making a local move where his address changes, but he is staying with the same pack, then have him fill out an application and write “CHANGE OF ADDRESS” at the top.

Scouts that transfer from another pack must also fill out an application and write “TRANSFER” at the top of the application. They need to know their previous Council, Pack, and Den.

Please look over the applications to insure that they are filled out on both sides and look to make sure that they are filled out completely.

Scout Dues

For each Scout \$60 in annual dues are to be collected. They can be paid at once in September – or in two payments; \$30 in September and \$30 in January. Dues cover the costs of registration, the initial handbook, neckerchief, slide and each Scout receives a subscription to Boy’s Life.
